Regulate e-cigarette policy: Assn of Vapers India

Requesting the Tamil Nadu Government to withdraw the ban on e-cigarette and regulate it in the state, members of Association of Vapers India (AVI) that represents e-cigarette users across the country discussed on how can e-cigarettes benefit human health and help combat the increased use of tobacco in the state.

The state government's proposal to ban e-cigarettes was announced by health minister C. Vijayabaskar in the assembly last month. The members of the association made the appeal to state health minister and health secretary J Radhakrishnan on Friday. Vaping is an act of inhaling and exhaling the water vapor produced by e-cigarettes, which deliver nicotine in the form of a vapour. It has become common among youngsters these days as an alternative to quit smoking.
